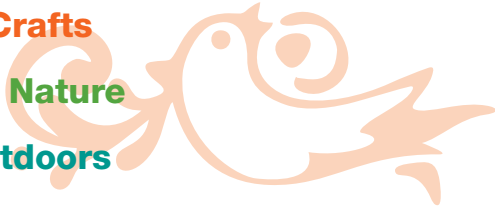

Tuition is \$250 per week before June 1, 2021 and \$265 after June 1, 2021. A \$50 per week deposit (non-refundable) is required at time of registration, and this deposit is applied to the tuition total.
