Unfortunately, the Covid-19 Delta variant is causing a sharp rise in infections in our area. The following restrictions must be followed to avoid spread.

- **Everyone, including children, must wear a mask while indoors.**
- **We request masking outdoors when in groups that can't maintain a social distance of 6 feet.**
- No eating or drinking is permitted indoors during Meeting activities.
- Those **unvaccinated** for Covid-19, including children, are also **requested to keep a social distance of 6 feet from others when indoors.**
