Gwynedd Friends Meeting now offers a peace camp experience for children aged 3-5. This camp is modeled after the Peace Camp that Gwynedd has successfully run for 15 years.

Your young child will have an opportunity to explore what peace means through stories, cooperative games, arts and crafts, music, and service projects.

Most of our time will be spent outside on the beautiful grounds of Gwynedd Meeting, using the fields, wooded trails, gardens, and play areas around the meetinghouse.

There are three camp sessions:

August 1-5 August 8-12, and **August 15-19**.

Children are welcome to come to one, two, or all three weeks.

The camp day runs from 9:00-1:00. Early drop-off and extended care (from 1-3 PM) are available for those with siblings in Peace Camp for an extra fee.

Children bring their own lunch, and healthy snacks are provided. This is a tree nut/peanut-free environment.

Scholarship assistance is available. Donations to the scholarship fund gladly accepted!

Tuition is \$200 per week. Extended care is \$20 a day or \$80 a week. Registration

opens February 1st. A \$50 deposit per week is required at the time of registration, with the balance due by June 1st.
